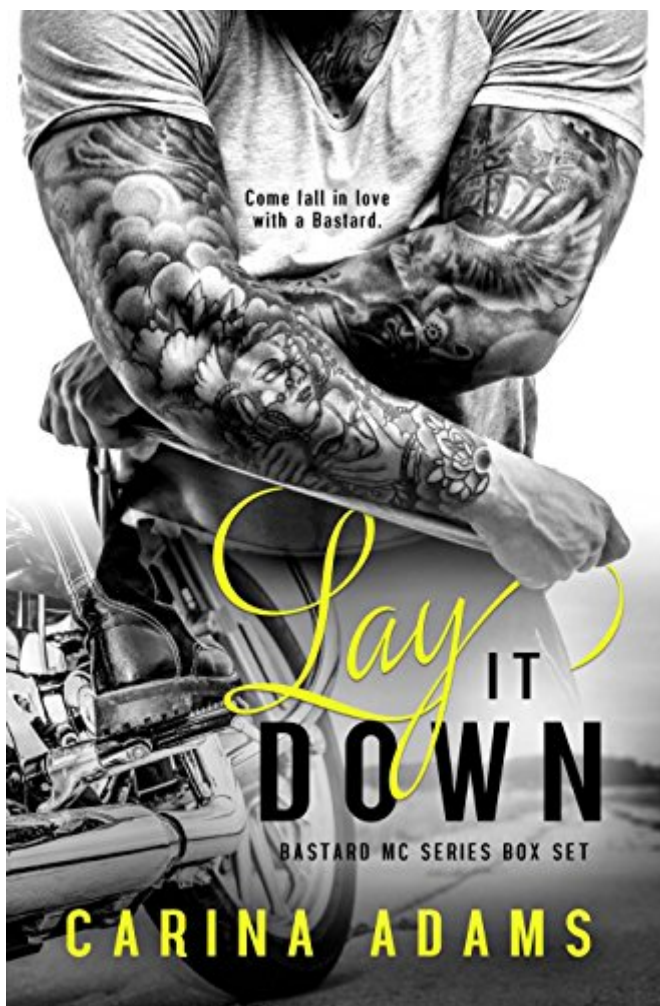


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Lay It Down: Bastards MC Duet

There are two books in this set - Always Be Mine & Honey Whiskey. In Always Be Mine we get to know Josephine and Matty. At first it didn't

feel like an MC book, it gets more MC about half way through. Jo and Matty are best friends and have always been there for each other. When Jo and her husband separate Matty is there for her. Jo starts to really see Matty and their friendship for what it really is. As they explore their feelings, Matty has secrets that he is concerned will cause Jo to go back to her husband. Of course things get even more complicated with the exes, and secrets. This causes a heartbreaking separation for these two. Will they be able to come back together in book 2? In Honey Whiskey I had a level of frustration with Matty and Jo. Could these two not stop fighting for one moment and enjoy each other?
