

The maps, which are usually a strong point of Fodor guides, are very hard to understand. There's lots of good information here but overall I'm disappointed with this book.

This is filled with useful information. Everything from what to see, what to pack, and what money to use.

Lacks information. This guide is basic and more thorough than the National Geographic guide- but Fodor's really should hire some people to do some in depth investigation of the areas featured in the book.
