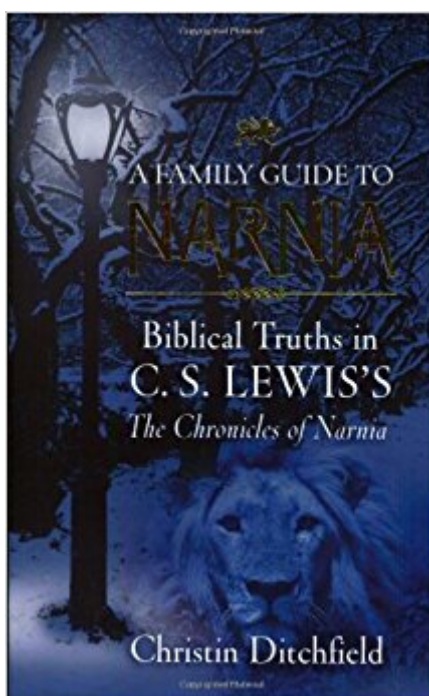

The Chronicles of Narnia series have been my top favorite books for years and I'm glad to have found this book. There are typos here and there, but they're no big deal. It's an easy enough read for kids to understand, but not enough to bore teen and adult readers.

I'm just getting started with this. This is not something to do as a "quick read"! In order to get the full depth, it must be done very deliberately, & a little at a time in order to digest the amazing beauty that this Guide illuminates of Lewis' Narnia series. I highly recommend reading this "Guide" together with each Narnia book to obtain the awesome riches hidden there. I never recall reading this incredible series, so my method will be to read one book (in order), then read & study the accompanying Truth as expounded by Ditchfield. He has a brief, but DEEP study of each book, chapter by chapter. In that way I will work my way through this amazing challenge to learn so much more of the countless gems hidden in God's Word, & as presented in the unique way of CS Lewis, along with the "Study Guide" presented by Chrisin Ditchfield. A must-have for any serious student of God's Word!
