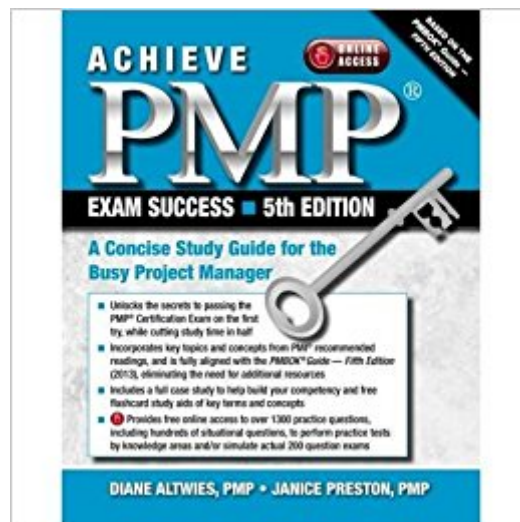

The book is a decent study guide to supplement the PMBOK, however, it didn't come with any flashcards as it says it should on the front of the book, AND I haven't been able to log into the website for online testing because the site will not send a verification email to complete my registration. I've also noticed one or two questions in the book, with answers that are clearly wrong. (I went back to the PMBOK and verified). Chapter 2, #11 is not C, it's A. I'm sure it's just a typo, but that could be pretty crucial to someone who doesn't know better. It also mentions a CD-rom that should've come with the book. Nope, didn't get that either. The whole point is to be able to take practice tests so that is a big disappointment. Update: I contacted customer service yesterday and they were very helpful. They responded within an hour and informed me that the website is undergoing maintenance and provided me with a generic passcode that I am able to use to log in and take practice exams. The text does mention a CD-rom and flashcards, but that is all incorporated on the website now according to them. The flashcards can be printed from the website and the various chapters in the book remind you to do that. The misprints can't be helped at this point, but I'm giving this book a 3-star rating (up from 1-star). Customer service is excellent and all the information is available, but the fact still remains that the book isn't as polished as it should be. However, along with the PMBOK, I believe the information in this book will help you pass the test but there is no substitute for reading and due diligence.

This is the 2nd exam review book I've purchased after being very disappointed with the "Head First" PMP title. This is a comment I left comparing the two books. I may return to write a full review later. I wrote a negative review on the Head First book here:

This is what I came up with:I purchased "Achieve PMP Exam Success, 5th Edition: A Concise Study Guide for the Busy Project Manager" by Diane AltwiesI believe this book is written by two people who teach PMP material. It's an excellent resource as it does two things remarkably well: 1) It explains the key concepts in intelligent and eloquent ways. I cannot emphasize enough how important this is to me. 2) it explains a simple and thorough methodology to pass the exam. These are serious pros who have helped scores of people pass the exam so their views appear to be more than a little authoritative. This too I value highly.Essentially, it's about quality vs. graphical style. In education, the quality of the material in how well it conveys information is utterly essential. Finding material prepared by professional instructors is a great way to gain value from their years of experience in education. Graphical style is far less important. The Head First material (and I assume the entire collection of books is similarly styled) is graphically entertaining which is perhaps compelling to the ADHD generation we have all become with out gadgets and incessant interruptions. Studying, at least for me, requires carefully constructed material and focus. The disarming graphics are far less important with the singular exception of selling books.Overall, I find that my confidence grows while reading this book. When reading the Head First book, I found myself getting increasingly aggravated due to the muddled and confused explanations.This discussion reminds me of teachers/professors. Some are charming, charismatic, and demonstrative people who focus on their disarming and entertaining style more than the quality of the material & to what extent the students are understanding and absorbing material. These are the professors who win awards for student popularity and in some schools, this brings professional advancement and pay raises. There are other less charismatic and charming professors who work like hell to build compelling and inspired material and present it carefully. They tend to challenge their students more and are shunned by those who want good grades more than an excellent education. Their peers understand and respect their efforts but many of the students don't see the need or value of dealing with them. This is exactly the difference I see between these two books. What are you looking for? A fun book or an excellent book? It's the PMP Exam for God's sake, look for fun after you pass the exam.

Passed the PMP today, but not because of this book. I had high hopes for the book to help me be efficient in my self study for the PMP, but the online section was terrible! The state college in my

area offers an in depth PM course which I took a few years ago, but due to a few unforeseen issues, I had to delay taking the test. I thought this book and online access was the a good idea since it was on the PMI website, but I was WRONG! The book by itself is of good value if you have a foundation in PM already, but the PMP test is about testing yourself on various scenarios. Once you read the PMBOK you will need a resource that will compliment your studies and the online test is confusing and frustrating to use. Repeated online testing is what helped me solidify my comfort with the exam questions and format. Unfortunately , this online access did not offer any statistics about my progress, some the questions were grammatically wrong, and some of the answers did even make sense. I did contact one of the authors and she responded that improvements were coming, but that is not going to help me pass the test. The online area is undeveloped and raw and not worth your time. My coworkers suggested RMC and I wish I wouldn't have wasted time or money on this product. I abandoned ship and switched to RMC project management online access for \$300. The online access and the format is terrific! RMC gives you the ability to test by knowledge area or by process group, then your information is stored for review later. Your progress is collated and averaged and you can run various reports. There are even explanations to why your answer is right or wrong and references back the study guide to research (I skipped the RMC book). Disappointed that this didn't work, but I couldn't jeopardize my testing for a product that needs to mature.
