

Laura Ingalls Wilder (1867–1957) was born in a log cabin in the Wisconsin woods. With her family, she pioneered throughout America's heartland during the 1870s and 1880s, finally settling in Dakota Territory. She married Almanzo Wilder in 1885; their only daughter, Rose, was born the following year. The Wilders moved to Rocky Ridge Farm at Mansfield, Missouri, in 1894, where they established a permanent home. After years of farming, Laura wrote the first of her beloved Little House books in 1932. The nine Little House books are international classics. Her writings live on into the twenty-first century as America's quintessential pioneer story. Renée Graef received her bachelor's degree in art from the University of Wisconsin at Madison. She is the illustrator of numerous titles in the Little House publishing program, as well as Rodgers and Hammerstein's *My Favorite Things* and E.T.A Hoffman's *The Nutcracker*, adapted by Janet Schulman. She lives in Cedarburg, Wisconsin, with her husband and two children.

When my daughter got hooked to the audio version of the original Little House on the Prairie series, she wasn't quite old enough to read the real thing, but was in love with Laura. Welcome My First Little House Books. Winter Days in the Big Woods is one of her favorites, reminding her of the fun, family times Laura and her family would have trapped in their house through the many months of the Long Winter. Just as delightful as the original series, but easier for the little kids to capture when they're young.

I purchased this book for my daughter (18 months) because I LOVE Little House on the Prairie. The books and television show were my absolute favorite growing up, and in fact, I still watch them to this day on DVD. The paperback format is actually better suited for girls slightly older than mine (she could easily bend the pages if I let her run off with the book), but she sits through the story beautifully when I read it to her and brings it to me to read to her again and again. I'm actually a little surprised because I found this particular book to be a little boring in its composition. But hey, works for me! The illustrations are lovely. I definitely plan on buying more books in the "My Little House" series. If you want to pass Little House on to your girls, this is a great way to do it!

Doesn't everyone just love and remember "Little House on the Prairie" books? Since those chapter

books were written way over 25 years ago there are now so many others to buy. This newer set is for the younger generation of little girls to read, collect and enjoy. I have already started a collection for my granddaughter. The colors pop off the page, the stories are short so they will sit through the reading of the book.
