In this third sequel (and I do recommend reading the series in order,) I found Stacy Justice, a witch with a wonderful Great Dane, Thor, as her familiar messing up spells, growing as a witch, and fighting for justice once more. Stacy is a witch who lives in the open. Most of the town of Amethyst, Illinois knows that Stacy's family is 'special.' Stacy earns her living as a journalist following in her father's footsteps. Stacy finds herself at the annual Founder's Day picnic and mulling over the message she had received about her Father's death (not an accident but a murder,) when her beloved Thor goes missing. Casting a spell quickly, Stacy finds Thor, but also many surprises, such as dead bodies in the lake, Tigers appearing sent from her Mother in Ireland, resurrected and lost dogs, and more...But, what about her Father? Was he murdered, or was it an accident? Her Father was just a small town newspaperman, what was the reason for him to be murdered...but there was that cell phone call...This novel has humor, quirky characters, beloved animals, adventure, fast-paced plots, and just plain good story telling. I love how we get a reminder of where the last novel ended as this orientates me back into the story line after a good six or more months while waiting for the book to be published. I also appreciate the research and study the author has put into this series. Ms. Annino has studied the Irish Celtic mythology and even gives us, the readers, an 'Author's Note' that gives more information to further our own independent study of the same.

It just dawned on me that in my previous reviews of these books, I never mentioned Thor! How could I forget Thor! If you've gotten this far in the series you know Thor is Stacy's completely awesome, incredibly large and loveable familiar. Gotta love Thor! In this book Stacy gets a phone call saying her father's accidental death years ago was not an accident. But what could Dad have been involved in that would have gotten him killed? So we have another mystery. In this book Stacy finds a body in the lake, messes up a spell which brings a lot of dogs out of seemingly nowhere (one of them a really nasty chihuahua!) and once again, Stacy has her hands full. The same characters are back for another round of chaos.

I discovered the Stacy Justice series last year and loved them so much I couldn't wait for this book. I am happy to say this book was worth the wait. This book picks up where we left off. It felt so good to follow Stacy around. It felt like being home again with these characters. Stacy will not let things go until figures out the mystery. I said it before I'll say it again Stacy has to be one of my favorite female characters. She's strong, stubborn, funny and kick ass! Chance, her lovable eccentric aunts, grandmother, her cousin, Cinnamon (love that name) and Thor her great Dane and familiar are all

back as well. Here we go on another crazy ride to find out if her father had been truly murdered. This book was hilarious and kept me on the edge of my seat. If you're looking for hot sexy action this doesn't have it. But honestly you won't miss it. It works without it. Check this book out, I promise you won't regret it.
