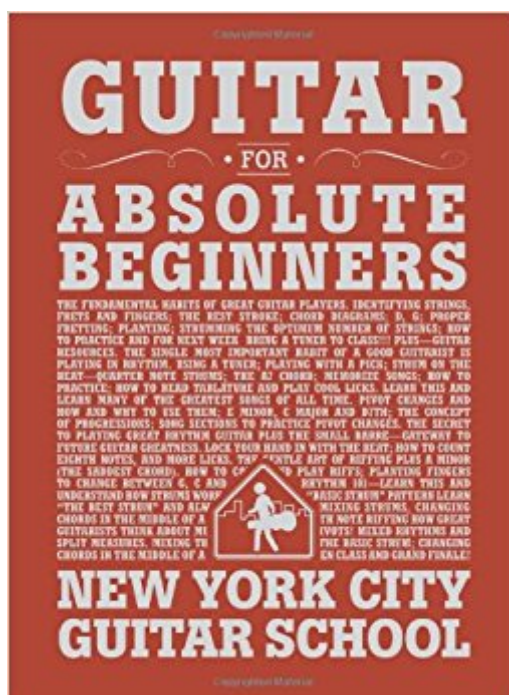

I have tried 5 different times to learn guitar and have given up every time. Both with and without an instructor. I'm about a third of the way through this and I have to say that I think I will actually follow through this time. Very focused, great pacing, no fluff, and I really like the author's encouraging attitude throughout the book. It's also really helpful how he puts things in perspective so, for example, when you're learning D, G, and A7 chords, he shows you how just those 3 chords can be used to play actual songs. Then you add another chord and you can play some more songs. And so on. Seems really obvious, but to a beginner like me it was a big revelation that I had been missing all this time. I wish it came with a CD, but I was able to find audio examples on the website. Great book. Hope this becomes an ongoing series.

First timer trying to self teach. This beginner book was amazing and broken down in the simplest form. Very easy to learn from it. The quality of the book itself was excellent.

If you are an absolute beginner, this is a great book to kick things off. The author has a great attitude about learning guitar, and you learn some fundamental chord transitions that really help you realize that playing guitar is not beyond the realm of possibility. There is also some important advice about rhythm as perhaps more key than perfect fingering to start playing actual songs. Given the price, you'd be crazy not to pick this up, even if you ultimately look elsewhere for your studies.

Pretty good instructions to get started the "right" way. Couple this book with the "NYC guitar school" YouTube videos and it's perfect for introducing you to guitar licks, and strumming and great for teaching you the necessary chords to play thousands of songs. It's also got some entertaining stories to keep you interested in learning the guitar. Totally happy with this purchase.

I always wanted to learn guitar. At 40 I decided to buy a telecaster. Luckily, I came across this book. A lot of beginner's book tell you the chord shapes and strumming patterns but don't actually tell you how to learn play guitar. This book does. By focusing on common chord progressions and the use of a capo you can learn to play hundreds of songs. You won't learn overnight but by practicing the

lessons in the book 30 minutes a day you should grasp the foundations and be on the road to playing a wide range of songs. Keep practicing, be patient.....and Good Luck!

Even if you've never even held a guitar before, this book will get you started. It's clear and concise and as a senior citizen who has never played guitar before, I've now learned a few chords.

After trying about a dozen other self-teaching guitar aids, I decided to try just one more before I gave up on my beautiful classical guitar. This one actually got me and my guitar on the road to a long-lasting relationship! The book addresses you like a beginner but not like an idiot. It's a completely unique approach that allows you to enjoy practicing and learning right from the first page. And as an older student (50+) I found it very easy to follow the logic of the lessons. I only wish I had started with this book when I first bought my guitar.

I paid around \$200 for registration and 1 month or 4 once a week - 40 minute guitar classes.. Yet with this book's first few pages I've learned more than I'll probably learn in 2-3 months of classes at my own pace.. The Price for this book is amazing seeing as all the information is extremely helpful and useful if one takes the time to consistently read through and practice the given exercises such as the chord changes, Helpful tips and advice that a tutor would probably miss out on telling you such as proper fretting, finger placement, which fingers to move in order to make your chords switches effortless with practice as well as lessons in rhythm, songs from artists that use certain chords..etc. I've just begun reading this book again although I purchased it a couple months ago and I regret not getting into the book as soon as I received it.

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
