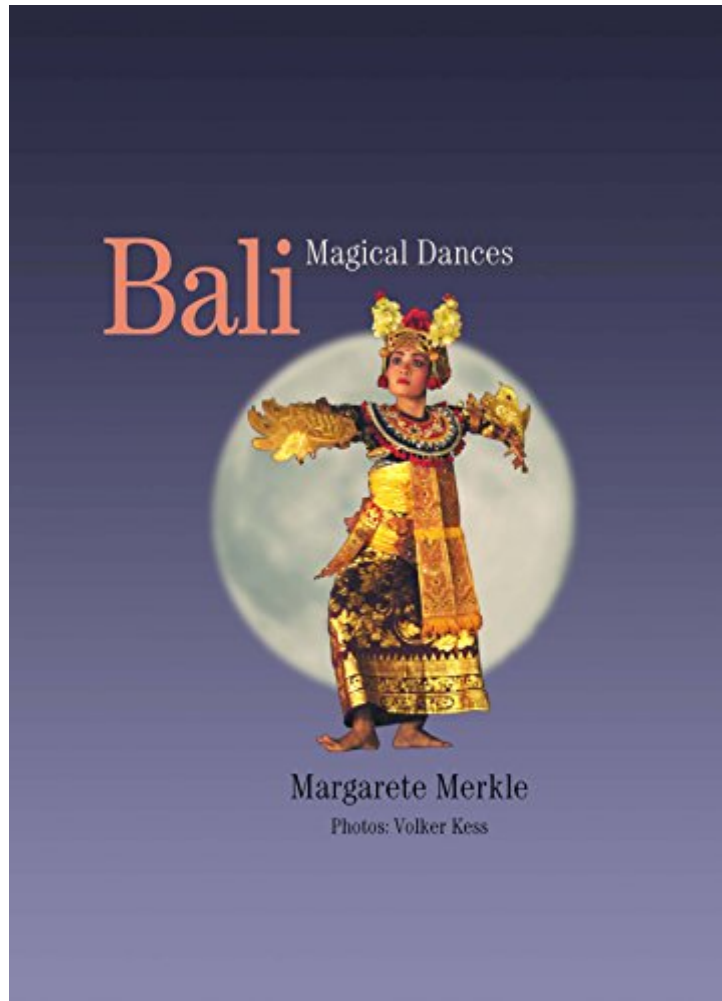




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Bali - Magical Dances

Bali - Magical Dances by Margarete Merkle The book deals with the forms, contents and societal meaning of Balinese dance. It shows the aesthetics of Balinese dance while highlighting the role of dance in Balinese society. It is of interest for all Bali enthusiasts - ethnologists, dramatists or theater visitors, dancers, actors and, in particular, travelers to Bali. The book accounts for the attraction that Balinese dance has on nearly every person who comes into contact with it. The reader gets to know a few dancers personally. They are presented in short portraits; one learns about their development, relationship to their art and their typical work day. The author: Margarete Merkle studied ethnology, dramatic arts and journalism in Berlin. In many trips to Bali she deepened her knowledge about Balinese dance, primarily through interviews and research. Professionally, she is working in the field of public relations and as a freelance journalist in Frankfurt am Main, Germany. The photographer: Volker Kess is a photographer and graphic designer. For years, he has worked as a nature and wildlife photographer in Indonesia and published his photos in numerous journals.
