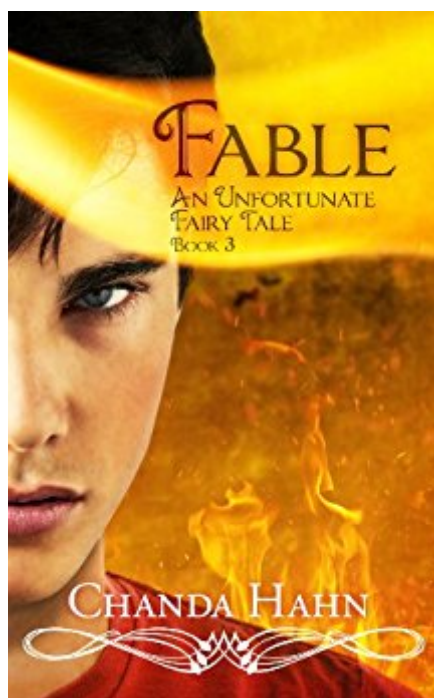

I loved that it kept you guessing. Toward the end of the books, I was ready for a fresh twist of events and that is what they gave me. I would read it again and love the character development over the course of the books in the series.

Keeps getting better and better.....and better at making me scream, smile, laugh, cry and run to the next book. No spoilers. The books just get more exciting and action packed each time. When I read a series I look forward to each book giving me something new and adding on to the series. Chanda Hahn's Unfortunate Fairy Tale series does

just that. Each book in the series manages to provide an episodic-type story while still continuing the main storyline. Fable, the third book in the series, continues this concept and is a wonderful addition to the series. What I enjoy most about Hahn's series is her creative take on the Grimm lore and how the fairy tales are incorporated into the story. Hahn created a story where there is more beyond what you know. Each book you learn something new about Mina and the Grimm curse, providing twists that bring the story and series to a new level. In Fable, you (along with Mina) gain further insight into the curse, Teague, and Jared. By the end of the book, you are left reeling from the many revelations and are anxiously waiting for the next book in the series to come out. With everything that is going on, the book still retains the charm and fun that existed from the very first book. Mina, while having grown from the first time you meet her, is still that insecure and awkward teenager. You still feel for her and she still has the ability to come off strong while still being vulnerable. You sympathize with her attempts to do the right thing at the cost of her own happiness in both her quest to eliminate the curse and her personal life, specifically her feelings for Brody and Jared (and if you are a fan-which I am-of Mina/Jared coupling this book will finally provide some long-awaited moments between these two). Fable was another entertaining installment in Hahn's An Unfortunate Fairytale series. It retained its charm found in previous books while providing action and some romance. The revelations revealed in this book adds new layers to Mina's journey that will make you eager to read more and find out what happens next.

At first read, I loved this book because the heroine was starting become her own person, stronger in who she really was. With each quest, she became more confident. This third book in the series lacked a little luster in the plot development; I thought the author would incorporate more of the school's musical theme into the quest, but that just fizzled out. And as I recall from the three I've read so far, it seems like Mina's always getting the short end of the stick and getting her heart broken, either because she's got too big a heart for others or because she's being screwed over by someone else. Hope the next one is a little more positive in the ending. Other than that, it's a good read.
