This is a fine, small (key word being small) reference booklet. I wouldn't rely on it solely by any means, but it would definitely be easy to carry in a pocket. I've included a photo comparing it to Rick Steves' Italian phrase book so you'll know exactly how tiny it is. The price difference was only \$3--I personally would rather pay that much more for a more comprehensive phrase book than pay \$6 for what's little more than a pamphlet.

This book will not have you fluent in Italian, but it is just what is needed to communicate in hotels, restaurants, tourist attractions and taxis. Small enough to carry with you without being a burden.
