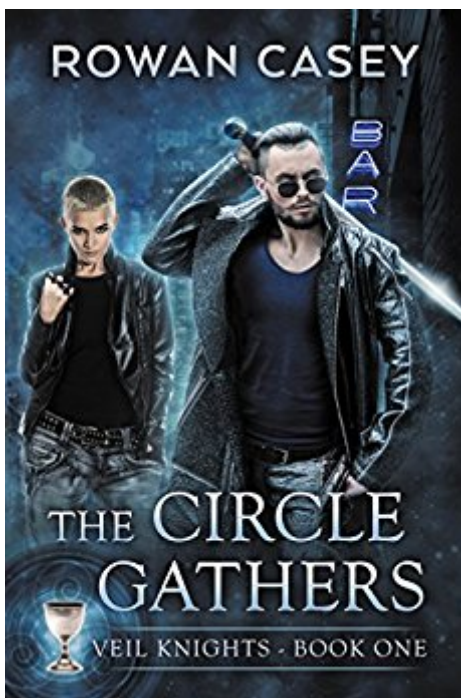


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# The Circle Gathers (Veil Knights Book 1)

There is a lot to like in this book. First off, the concept of "the old Arthurian guard returns", while not entirely new, seems fresh. Also, the story does not start out trying to force the reader to buy into that concept. It chooses, instead, to start off focused on a good, strong character, Jessie Noble, and to bring the reader into the fold along with her as she develops throughout that story. The story that The Circle Gathers tells is VERY engaging and very cinematic, one that will have you eager to read the next chapter.... which brings me to my only real complaint. At only 145 pages long I was certainly not read for this story to be over but since the second part is already available (The Hound of Night) and since the authors plan on a monthly release, I am definitely on board for the ride. As a fan of many of the authors who are a part of this project as well as a long time fan of fantasy, both urban and high, as well as the Arthurian mythos in particular, this book almost seemed like a no-brainer to me and I am sure glad that I went with that instinct. This is an incredibly fun read.

In the second book of the Veil Knights series we are introduced to John Seton, Scottish ex-pat and small time grifter. John is in L.A. escaping from his life in Scotland when he learns that he may, in fact, be a veil knight. Coming from a long slightly magical family line and in possession of a decidedly magical family heirloom, it doesn't take John long to get on board with the idea that he may be the modern day incarnation of a knight and get on with his quest to find his piece of the magical talisman that will keep the denizens behind the veil from invading the earth. John's piece of the talisman is a leather leash or harness which, conveniently, is somewhere in the greater L.A.

area. John's mysterious magical heirloom, a mirror containing an entity he calls Face, soon leads him to discover a long lost cousin with his own magic mirror, who is summarily executed by an invisible hound and his mirror taken. John tracks the hound and the leash to a man called The Collector far out in the Los Angeles hills. John unexpectedly finds information relating directly to his family history when he infiltrates the Collector's house in search of information regarding his quest. He also discovers that his piece of the talisman is what is controlling the spectral hound which killed his cousin. However, John and his comrades at the Scottish ex-pat bar he calls home are almost no match for the hound who chases John from the Collector's property. After a bloody struggle John obtains the leash only to immediately lose it to the mysterious Face in the mirror. In order to avenge his cousin and obtain his piece of the talisman John has to traverse across the veil and face what his ancestors helped to imprison many centuries before. The series continues to be intriguing. I thought it was odd, however, after all of the knights are introduced to each other in book one that they do not interact at all in book two. I'll have to wait around to see what happens in the later editions.

I wasn't sure what to expect from this book, having read about it in an author's newsletter. It was only \$0.99 when initially released, so I figured what did I have to lose? Had I known the fun that awaited me, I would have begun reading the book straightaway. It's got a breakneck pace, nail-biting action, compelling characters, and left me making delighted noises of frustration when I realized I'd finished it. Thankfully, I already own the second book in this series, which I've happily pushed to the #1 spot on my next-to-read list. If you're looking for deep literature, this probably isn't going to satisfy you. That's no criticism; I'm pretty sure that wasn't the intent. But if you want a quickie that will leave you breathless and wanting more, I wholeheartedly recommend this book. Download, and enjoy!
