

I took a class in Direction from Dr. Catron as a student at William & Mary and we used his textbook right after it was published. Over the years, I have read many books about play direction but Catron's is the one that I keep coming back to. This book gives you all the tools to really direct all aspects of a play. It is comprehensive yet practical. My favorite chapters are the ones on Working with Actors - this is an area where many directors struggle and Catron's advice is spot on. He presents a list of different actor challenges, how to identify them and then what to do. I was lucky enough to be in a couple of plays directed by Dr. Catron and he was an excellent director. This text is highly recommended for both novice and experienced directors.

Dr. Catron's book melds theory with practicality in the most utilitarian Directing primer on the market. Designed, I believe, as a college text, it has strong application at the professional and community theatre levels, better than Cohen/Harrop, John Miles-Brown and Dean & Carra. The only book which comes close to Catron's is Benedetti's *The Director at Work*.
