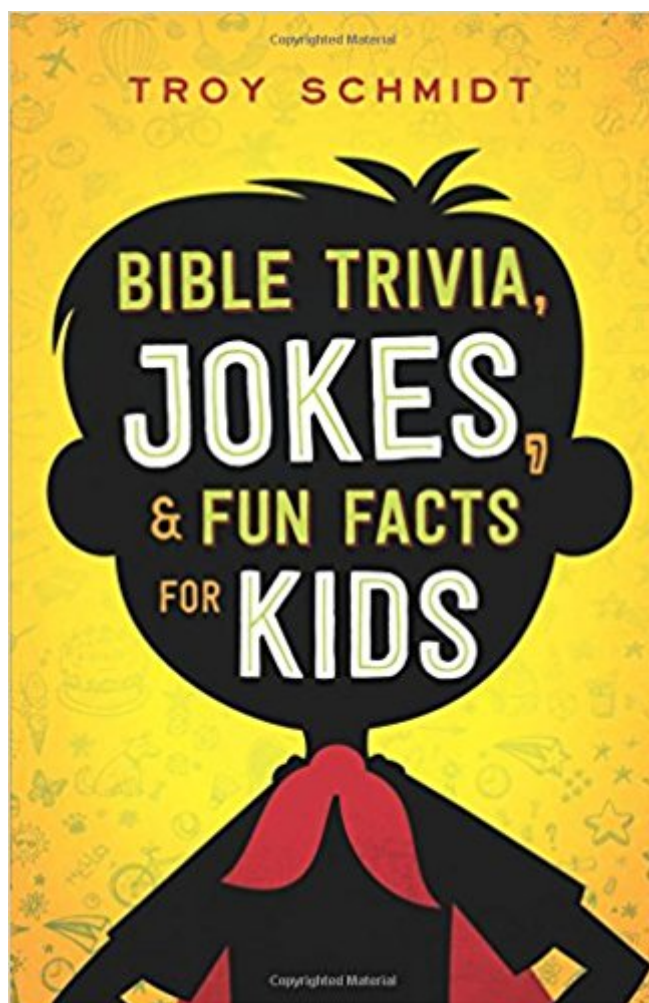

This book is full of fun jokes, riddles, and word games that are perfect for kids who need to engage their brains, yet want to have some fun. While it certainly has a ton of Biblical references, it isn't a bible study or scriptural type book. This is a book for fun. It starts with knock-knock jokes, perfect for a middle graders sense of humor. There are some silly biblical quizzes and fill in the blank knowledge tests that will really exercise their minds and memories. Later in the book, there is a section called Bible Banter which is a fun series of silly jokes like statements that are sure to keep you smiling, if not laughing aloud. Overall, this small book is the perfect tool to add to your arsenal for combating those inevitable summer boredom complaints. Why We Like It! I really appreciated how age appropriate this book is. And that it will appeal to boys- which let's be honest, tend to be left behind in the book department once they reach middle grades. This is for those kids who are solid readers, as there are complex sentences structures and words throughout. However, an older sibling could certainly entertain a primary school kid or even a kindergartner with the silliness in these pages. My kids were great big fans of the knock knock jokes.

Bible Trivia, Jokes, and Fun Facts for Kids by Troy Schmidt makes it fun to learn biblical facts and to get familiar with navigating the Bible. There are plenty of jokes and riddles in this book, but even better are the sections of Bible trivia, prompts, lists, fill-in-the-blanks and more that encourage readers to delve into their Bibles and find the answers they don't already know. This little gem is a sure bet for the middle school set, and its quick, short chapters and activities are appealing and fun. The "Did You Know?" sections are full of trivia facts and spark interest in learning more about the people, places, and events of ancient times: "Did you know there's a city in Star Wars that uses a name from the Bible? In 1 Samuel 28, King Saul paid a medium (someone who contacts the dead) to help him. That woman lived in Endor. In Star Wars: Return of the Jedi, Endor is a Forest Moon and home of the Ewoks. May the Holy Spirit be with you!" (p. 77)

This book offers a really nice compilation of games, trivia, jokes, and facts to help children get more involved and interested in studying the Bible. The book is set up in chapters to include a vast array of tasks and brain teasers. Kids can match people in the Bible to their family members, fill in the blanks to Psalms, and even create words from other words in the Bible. Then there are the jokes for added humor, which many kids will find equally amusing. There were some that were not 100% to my liking, but then there were those that did give me a good chuckle: "Where did the wise men shop for the baby Jesus? Bed, Bethlehem, and Beyond" I'm not afraid to admit that I was also able to learn a thing or two from this book. In fact, I found a lot of what's included particularly interesting. You see, while there are tons of banter and activities offered to test children's knowledge of the Bible, there are several areas that also include major facts and information. Did you know "A drop in the bucket" originated from a verse in Isaiah 40? Was there really a left-handed army during Biblical times? Where can you find the longest verse in the Bible? You can discover answers and explanations to these three questions and much, much more in this book. It's also worth mentioning that the last chapter of the book, Are You on the Road to Heaven, takes a more serious side by offering several scripture passages on salvation, as well as a prayer to give our life over to Jesus by asking Him into our hearts. The best way to get kids to be kept in a book, or so I think, is by giving them information that keeps

their attention. Kids or those young at heart loves jokes they love to laugh and enjoy the quite moments in life and this book, Bible Trivia, Jokes, and Fun Facts for Kids by Troy Schmidt does that aplenty. I can say that I loved so many of the bits shared in the book and I also shared this copy with several adults that loved it as well. So many good things are amongst the pages of this book.
