

I learned interesting facts about everything from modesty and Islam, to the eastern shore of the Dead Sea, to the amazing water efficient kidneys of the camel, to the origin of words--and more! My favorite part of the book however, is its humor. It is written a bit tongue in

cheek with a subtle humor that makes it a delight. If you are touring this part of the world or never want to leave your recliner --except in your imagination, this book is for you.

This is a delightful, fact-filled, little book. I wish I had read it before I visited some of these places. The authors are informed, honest, and funny.
