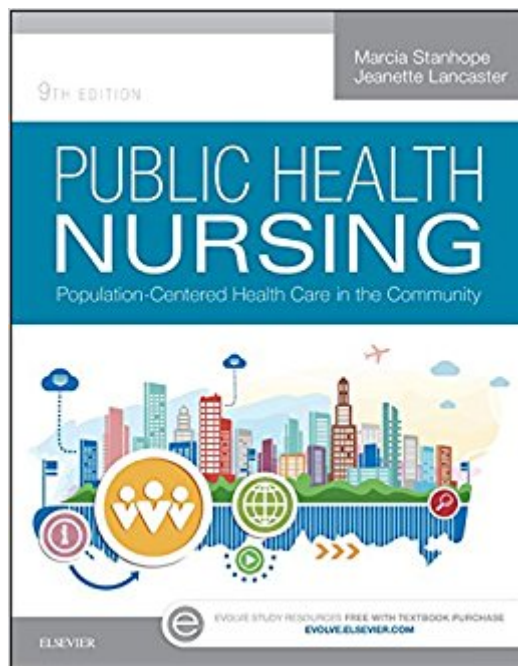


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# Public Health Nursing - E-Book: Population-Centered Health Care In The Community
