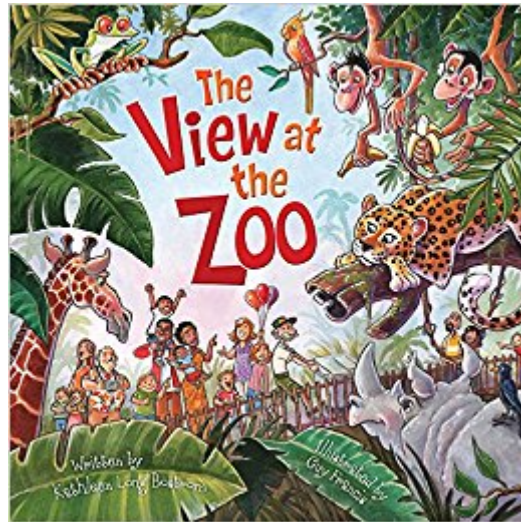

My toddler loves animals.. So this book was a big hit! If you have ever taken your little one to the zoo or intend to, this is a perfect book to read afterwards! The illustrations are so bright and fun, the

rhythm of the story flows so nicely that my toddler is able to read along and say the rhyming words, and it is just a cute book that introduces some really cool animals. It's Short enough to keep the attention of young ones but long enough to tell a good story and teach along the way. Highly recommend! We read it every night before bed.

The story is pretty simple, but the illustrations add a lot to the book. The story is about what the ANIMALS see at the zoo, but that is not necessarily apparent in the reading alone. When you look at the images, eventually you get that the people and the animals are essentially the same so the text represents both the humans and the animals... and at the end of the book it is more apparent that its the animal's perspective. Good book to read before going to the zoo.
