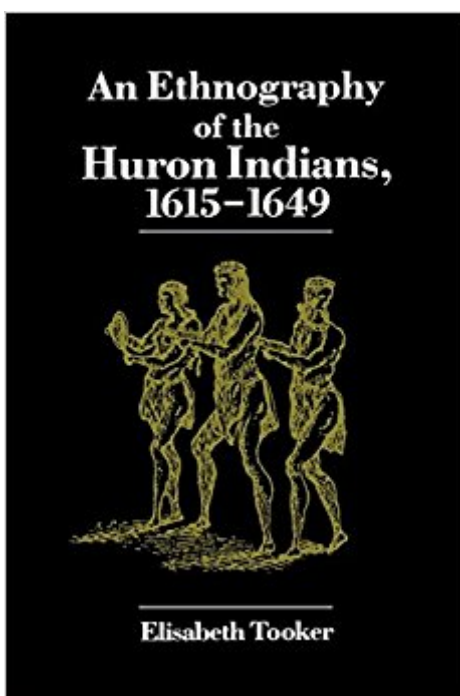


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Ethnography Of The Huron Indians: 1615-1649 (Iroquois & Their Neighbors (Paperback))
