

Well laid out and perfect transition level from Grade 2 to 3. My granddaughter did struggle with some of the math and half way through the book, she grandchild lost interest. This would be good for the first month of home school as a refresher before the real work begins.

Fairly decent... wish it had 3 digital math, actually more math in general would have been a big improvement. The biggest positive is my daughter liked doing it... loved the stickers and sticker grid. I liked how most of the exercises were doable for independent work.

My child & I have been having a lot of fun working through this book on summer break. Nothing has been too terribly challenging, just a fun way to keep the information from the past school year fresh. I love the Map that tracks the journey through the book and reward stickers for each thing completed.

Great for summer review and to prevent summer slide! There's a good variety of subjects, and the sticker map is fun and motivating too. Every level, bonus question, and outdoor adventure quest completed gets a sticker to add to the pull-out map. I like how each level rotates through different subjects in order to prevent boredom. For example: one page might be language arts, then science, next math, then social studies, etc. The outdoor adventure quests are a nice change of pace too. The pages are high quality as well. I was looking forward to ordering this workbook, and I'm glad I did!

I really like this book. My kid is most of the way through it, and I think it's really helping prepare him for 3rd grade. My only complaint is I think there should be a bit more of the more abstract type of math that 2nd graders do, to keep that fresh. But it does very well with the more straightforward skills.

This is a fun book that is relatively self-guided for my 2nd grader. She loves the 'map' to see her progress and likes all of the different activities.
